Winters City Council On behalf of Valley Clean Energy (VCE), a community choice aggregation (CCA) program Gary Sandy serving Yolo County, I write to express our support for SB 99 (Dodd), a bill that seeks to to

help local governments develop clean energy resilience plans.

Don Savlor VCE is the not-for-profit public electricity provider serving over 120,000 customers in Yolo County Board of Supervisors unincorporated Yolo County and the cities of Woodland, Davis, and Winters. As a locally governed public entity we are focused on providing cost effective clean electricity while Tom Stallard

improving the communities we serve through local reinvestment of our revenues.

Mayra Vega California homeowners, businesses and utilities have been rapidly investing in new fossil-Woodland City Council fuel generators, primarily diesel generators, to prepare for planned and unplanned power

outages. Relying on fossil-fuel generators to power homes and businesses for any reason runs counter to California's clean energy and climate goals. However, distributed energy resources (DERs), generation and storage resources, can provide the type of energy resilience that diesel generators provide without the associated emissions. To realize the potential clean energy resilience of DERs, a coordinated plan between utilities and local governments is needed to expedite development of DERs and locate them in a way to maximize their benefits.

This bill requires the CEC to develop and implement a technical assistance and grant program to support development of clean community energy resilience plans led by local governments, including CCAs. VCE is well positioned to work with our member jurisdictions and incumbent-owned utility, PG&E, to develop an energy resilience plan for Yolo County and its cities, but we need financial and technical support from the California Energy Commission as well as the cooperation of PG&E and SB 99 will deliver on those needs.

For these reasons, we support SB 99 and thank Senator Dodd for his leadership. We respectfully request your "Aye" vote when the bill is heard in committee.
